General Information

- Sponsorship** The contest is sponsored by Muscatine Against Human Trafficking, a project of the Rotary Club of Muscatine and Muscatine Community College
- Eligibility** All 16 through 22 year olds who live in the following school districts: Muscatine, Louisa-Muscatine, Columbus Junction, West Liberty, Wilton and Durant. All entries should be submitted on an individual basis. No shared work is allowed
- Entry Limit** One poster per person
- Deadline** Entries must be submitted by 11:59 pm on April 1, 2023

Poster Requirements

- Objective** The objective is to design a poster specifically addressed to 16 through 22 year olds with Human Trafficking prevention information that is engaging for the age group.
- Content** Text should be bi-lingual: English and one other language chosen by the participant. Posters should not contain any personal details like name of the participant. This information should be in the registration form only.
- Poster Size** Poster can be horizontal or vertical, and should be printable on 8.5x11
- Media** Any mixed media suitable for reproduction as a poster is allowed, including computer-generated graphics. Posters must be two-dimensional. All posters must be original art. No trademarked or copyrighted images or phrases should be used.
