**Notes from last Friday:** Pat Olsen was Zoom host and Jeremy Kaiser presided. Attendance was almost 50. Guests were Norlan Hinke (Clinton) and District Governor Erna Morain (Waukee), who presented a certificate of appreciation to President Jeremy for his excellent leadership. She thanked North Scott Rotary for its support (\$1,600) of her Food Bank initiative. Norlan Hinke chairs the committee that will review district grants on Saturday. "You have a good shot at it," he said of Brad Burt's proposal to provide technology to students who need it most.

President Jeremy reported:

- The club will purchase a Zoom account. He thanked Pat Olsen, Jeff Ashcraft and Joe Stutting for allowing the club to use theirs.
- Beginning July 1, meals at the Steeplegate will increase to \$14. That will be the charge for guests and Visiting Rotarians.
- The board determined that meetings from March 12 to July 10 will not count toward personal attendance records.
- Tom Messer has arranged for the annual Golf Outing to be Friday, Sept. 11 at Glynn's Creek.

Other:

- Josie Seymour said the board decided there will be no cost for members and guests to attend the Installation Party.
- Carolyn Scheibe thanked the club for \$1,000 for a ramp for the North Scott Food Pantry. The goal has been met.
- Paul Holzworth asked whether he should arrange for pianists for meetings at the Steeplegate. Answer: Yes.
- North Scott Rotary contributed \$1,500 to PolioPlus.
- Pat Olsen expected to be the father of another daughter before Monday morning.
- Sergeant-at-arms Kelly Meyer levied fines with Father's Day trivia.
- Speaker Allie Stutting gave an inspirational message while on the road in Missouri. Four things which shaped her life, she said, were her parents, her faith, the North Scott School District and North Scott Rotary.
