Guests were **Norlan Hinke** (Clinton) and **District Governor Erna Morain** (Waukee), who presented a certificate of appreciation to **President Jeremy** for his excellent leadership. She thanked North Scott Rotary for its support (\$1,600) of her Food Bank initiatiave. **Norlan Hinke** chairs the committee that will review district grants on Saturday. "You have a good shot at it," he said of **Brad Burt's** proposal to provide technology to students who need it most.

President Jeremy reported:

• The club will purchase a Zoom account. He thanked **Pat Olsen, Jeff Ashcraft** and **Joe Stutting** for allowing the club to use theirs.

• Sergeant-at-arms **Kelly Meyer** levied fines with Father's Day trivia.

• Speaker **Allie Stutting** gave an inspirational message while on the road in Missouri. Four things which shaped her life, she said, were her parents, her faith, the North Scott School District and North Scott Rotary.
