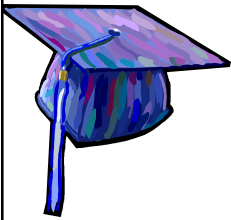

RYLA is a day-long leadership program for sophomore students which demonstrates Rotary's respect and concern for youth. Participants learn methods of responsible and effective voluntary youth leadership through a training experience that encourages continued and stronger leadership of youth by youth. The conference also publicly recognizes high qualities of many young people who are rendering service in their communities as leaders, and provide positive motivation.

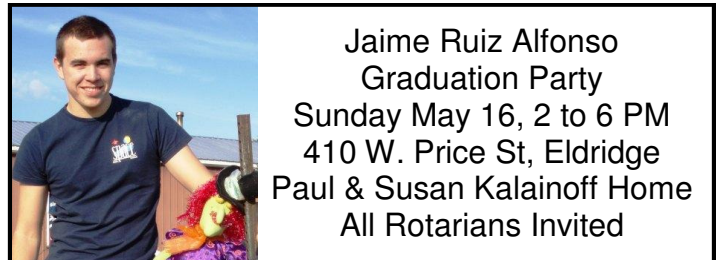
