## Honor Flight, Bob Morrison, Bert Vigen



### **Bob Morrison**

Bob Morrison is volunteer Hub Director of Honor Flight of the Quad Cities. His board formed the Honor Flight Hub with a public announcement July 3rd 2008. World War II Veterans are sent to Washington DC to see their memorial at no cost to them. They range from 81 to 96 years old, some of whom have never flown in an airplane.

Eight flights have been sent so far averaging 100 veterans per trip. This year began with two flights in April and one in May. We hope to provide as many as eight total flights in 2010.

Bob has a degree in Marketing from the University of Iowa. He worked in sales and credit for the Sherwin Williams Company and in finance with GMAC in Moline. He then turned to the not-for-profit sector as Education Director and Development Director with New Hope Foundation and United Marriage Encounter; both out of Muscatine.

Two years ago, he accepted the Development Director position at Ridgecrest Village, one of the most respected retirement communities in the Quad City area. He has recently added the Ridgecrest Marketing Department to his duties. As a Certified Senior Advisor (CSA), Bob helps seniors find ways to improve their quality of life.
