### **November 20: Teresa Paper, Foundation Chair**

Teresa Paper, Bill Tubbs, Chuck Briegel, Serge Pasheev and Bob Bainter gave reports about various important Rotary items. Bill spoke about the push to eradicate polio and the importance of safe homes and clean water for children in poverty stricken countries. Chuck told about the Ambassadorial Scholar that attended Iowa State University in 1960 and developed high protein milk biscuits for needy children in Australia. Serge gave details about the Group Study Exchange teams and how they are selected. Bob explained the requirements to become a Paul Harris Fellow with donations to Rotary International. Teresa closed the program with information about the Annual Fund and ways Rotarians can donate life insurance proceeds, etc. to Rotary programs.

Students were present from Davenport North High School. They were Kyle Thiessen and Elizabeth A. Walton. They were accompanied by Dr. Betsy Fair, representing Davenport North. Kyle is a team captain for the football team and participates in track. He works at The Great Escape and has his own landscape business, Quality Plus Lawns. Elizabeth is in Band, Choir, Color guard, National Honor Society, Key Club, and Student

Senate and does Irish dancing.

Other guest Rotarians present on Friday, November 20 were Bill Cameron from the Keokuk club, Frank Klipsch and Ralph Heninger from the Davenport club and Tony Calabrese from the Bettendorf club. Ralph brought 2 Iowa Hawkeye Basketball tickets and a parking pass to be auctioned at the club meeting. Tony bought them for \$40.

Kim Wilkins reported on the outdoor planter that was constructed at HDC on the previous Saturday. Glenn Eakes, Dr. Fred Green and five Assumption students helped haul dirt and concrete blocks to build the raised planter for the residents to use next spring. Jeff Ashcraft was the Sergeant and used a different approach to collect funds. He had several people "feel the power" and become mini sergeants to fine one or two people.
