Meeting Notes:  
Jim Schebler: Davenport  
German School Museum

Jim and Maureen Schebler are tireless volunteers at the Davenport School Museum located in the lower level at the Administrative offices on Brady Street. Both have a strong background and interest in History and Social Studies. They currently are digitalizing items in the museum so that the collections can be shown in computer presentations.

Jim presented numerous interesting facts about the schools in Davenport to the other 55 attendee's. In 1858 Antoine LeClaire loaned \$500 at 10% interest to start the first school. That money was paid back to him in a few months, as the interest rate was too high. In 1874 the German language was introduced into the Davenport Schools. The west side of town received more German instruction than the East side. In 1911 the schools were named for the

President's of the United States. Previous to that each school just had a number. Music and PE materials were carried from school to school by the teacher that taught the subject.

Guests present were: Seth Porter, guest of Rob White, Marcia Brandt, guest of Don Brandt, Melanie Blazevic, guest of Julia Blazevic and Maggie Patten, guest of James Patten.

Merle Anderson asked for volunteers for the John Deere Classic and Dr. Anita for the Moonlight Chase water stop on July 9. Becky promoted the Baseball Game and Bill Tubbs expressed his concern about the Eldridge Post Office partial cut back in services. Donations to the Educational Fund were: Ken Tank \$20 for granddaughter History Day project, Walter Bredbeck \$20 for granddaughter accepted into medical school and Gene Hoth \$20 for final sergeant duties and thanking the club for all the time given to Per Mar at the Iowa Hawkeye Football games in the past five years. Gene also collected \$14 in fun fines.
