Bill Gluba is the current mayor of Davenport, Iowa. He served on the Scott County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors (1977-1980) as well as in the Iowa State House (1971-72) and Senate (1973-76) as a Democrat. He has unsuccessfully run for Congress in Iowa's 1st Congressional District three times, first against Congressman Jim Leach in 1982, and again in 1988. In 2004 he was nominated to run against incumbent Congressman Jim Nussle and was defeated. On November 6, 2007, Gluba was elected Mayor of Davenport, Iowa.-

Bill was born October 7, 1942, in Davenport, Iowa. He attended schools in Davenport and then the University of Iowa. He is of the Roman Catholic Faith and a Realtor, currently with Re/Max River Cities in Bettendorf, Iowa
