Oaxaca, Mexico—Gardens For Life Project
The Rotary Clubs of Davenport, Bettendorf, North Scott and Iowa Quad Cities teamed up to co-sponsor a Rotary Foundation Matching Grant to provide sustainable living for the garbage pickers in Oaxaca, Mexico. The Gardens For Life Project aims to secure food provisions for the recycler families that live in the different landfills of Oaxaca and to improve the nutrition and eating habits of children of low-income families that attend schools in the periphery of the city, while also caring for the environment.

The Rotary Club of North Scott pledged \$500 towards the project. Along with the other pledged amounts and Rotary International Matching Grants The total amount of the project will be over \$10,000
