End Polio Now

Bill Tubbs took another trip of a lifetime, as he travelled with many other Rotarians, to help administer polio vaccine to innocent children in India. In three days, some 172 million children age 5 and under received the oral polio vaccine. Two little drops are all it takes. As of January 2012, India celebrated one year with NO new cases of polio. The last new cases reported in February 2012 were: 11 in Pakistan, 4 in Afghanistan, 2 in Nigeria and one in Chad. This is a wonderful accomplishment for Rotary and personally for Bill. Bill thinks that volunteering is good for the soul and makes you a better citizen in your own community.

Sixty two attended on Friday. Guests included Rotarian Jake Jacks from the Iowa QC Club, Linda Tubbs and Tom Koska, with Per Mar, a guest of Gene Hoth. Bert Vigen gave \$25 to the education fund for his wedding anniversary.
