John owns a multi faceted farming operation near Donahue, Iowa. He farms the land he grew up on, and has expanded into much larger crop land and farms over 4,000

acres, his Cinnamon Ridge Dairy operation, confinement hog operations, cattle operations, chicken & broiler operation, goat herd, and a successful farm tour and entertainment site. He hosts groups from all around the world which tour his operations, and are treated to Iowa Farm hospitality with a home cooked meal prepared in John's Kitchen. Much of this is done in cooperation with John Deere. John is on the Scott County Extension Council, also the North Scott School Board, and member of the Iowa Jersey Cattle Club.

John has two Daughters, Amy and Kara. Amy graduated from Iowa State University, and worked literally from coast to coast, in Maine, and Seattle Washington. She was learning the operation of large automated dairy operations, so that she could convince her father this is the way to go. They are building a new, totally automated operation on their home site. Daughter Kara just graduated from North Scott High School in Eldridge, Ia. She was top in her class and is also attending Iowa State University this fall and plans to return home and join the family farming operation.

We are proud to announce that the North Scott Community Needs Committee Recommended and the Board of Directors approved the following Grants

- 1) **Scott County Juvenile Detention Center \$300**
--to be used for assisting incarcerated juveniles in obtaining their GED degrees.
- 2) **Family Resources \$500**
--to be used for the purchase of Leap Frog readers in the classroom for students with below-grade level reading skills
- 3) **Beta Sigma Phi (Laureate Gamma Nu chapter) \$500**
--to be used for the purchase of materials to make pillows and hats for cancer patients that are distributed at Quad City area hospitals
- 4) **Special Olympics \$3000**
--to be submitted for a contribution through the John Deere Classic's "Birdies for Charity" program
- 5) **Salvation Army \$1300**
--to be used for the purchase of new kitchen stoves to be used in their rehabilitation of their Transitional Housing Apartments
- 6) **Juan Diez Rancheros \$1400**
