World Affairs Seminar

Two weeks ago, 60 members and guests heard Jakob Arana, a North Scott High School Junior; tell about the World Affairs Seminar that he attended in June. North Scott Rotary paid his way to the one week event that was held in Waukesha, Wisconsin on the campus of Carroll College.

The theme of the seminar was "Sustainable Development". There were numerous speakers, most speaking of hopes for a greener society. Jakob compared most of the subjects he heard about, to his birth country of Bolivia, South America. He especially enjoyed the speaker, Rick White, Vice President of Wisconsin Energy Corp.

About 300 students attended from all over the world, including exchange students. Half of the students were local students. A favorite activity was construction of "garbage art". The World is in Your Hands.

A putting contest was held before the meeting and

brought in \$13. Cody Allen was a "first" time sergeant of arms and collected \$28 in fines. He has waited 3 years to be able to fine Jeff Schwiebert, for his coaching skills of the past. Others fined were Make Huse for receiving his blue badge, Sheila Volrath for being late, and Brad Burt for sponsoring a hole at the Genesis Golf Outing that Cody played in.
