Steve Suiter started out the Foundation program by saying it was a lighter fare today, with no stuffy charts or slide shows full of numbers. It indeed was an upbeat and informative presentation by Teresa Paper, Nancy Glawe and Steve.

Nancy referred to the article that Doug Petersen from Iowa QC Rotary had written for the district newsletter about Polio Plus and the Future Vision Guide that was on the tables. It had 6 areas of focus: Peace & conflict prevention/resolution, disease prevention and treatment, water and sanitation, maternal and child health, basic education and literacy and last economic and community development. These are areas that global grants can be obtained to work toward specific goals.

Teresa Paper was honored to present her first Paul Harris award to Lorraine Lynch.

Also a second one to Chris Connolly and a third one to Steve Suiter. She explained how points accumulated along with monetary donations, and that members could give points to other people for Paul Harris awards.

Steve Suiter referred to attending the Rotary International Convention and how it will change your

outlook on Rotary. Visiting Davenport Rotarian, Ralph Heninger, commented of the same experience. Steve reminded us that Chuck & Sherri Briegel had attended the convention in England two years ago and Chuck encouraged Rotarians to attend one if possible.

Other guests present on Friday were Mary Daniels, guest of Mardy Morrow and Nathan Kessler and Christine Garrow, who will both be joining soon. Gabriela Magalhaes, Dylan Beyhl and Dr. Betsy Fair were present from Davenport North High School. Cody Birely, Katie Swoboda and Tracy Denahy also attended from North Scott High School.

December birthdays were celebrated and \$15 was collected. John Maxwell was the sergeant and collected \$31 in fines. Teresa Paper gave \$20 to the Foundation, the amount of points the Huskers made against the Hawks in Football the previous week. Bob Bainter was the winner of \$47 in Cody Allen's Football contest from the week before and he also gave it to the Foundation.
