Recently returned from serving on the Rotary International Council on Legislation. This council sets the standards followed by all Rotarians, worldwide.

One of the items of special interest was District 6000's proposal for official recognition of our Rotex Organization. This is the group of International Exchange Students whom have returned to the US. They serve in many ways including:

Training of new outbound students.

Organizing and chaperones for North Scott Rotary's Spring Youth Retreat.

Chaperoning and training at the Winter training event in Indianola.

Helping Paul Kalainoff and the committee in training the outbound students at Pella in March each year.

Chaperoning at the District 6000 annual conference.

Many other items.

Rotex is very active in Europe, but is has not been officially recognized by Rotary International

Although it will not impact District 6000 or our interaction with this group:

We are sorry to say that this proposal was not passed at this meeting.

Even though we had not been asked for financial considerations before hand, this was brought up as a negative item. We had information that the group would be self sustaining, which we were not able to present.

This seemed to be the determining factor in the defeat of this proposal this time around. We will continue involving this group as in the past, and pursue its recognition in the future.
