Fillmore School Environmental Tree Planting In Honor Of Sandy Hook Elementary School Shooting



On Tuesday, June 4, North Scott Rotary, with direct funds from District 6000, planted 3 sugar maples at Fillmore Elementary School in Davenport in honor and memory of those killed last December 14, 2012, at Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown, CT. The sugar maples were planted together in a small grove on the southeast side of the school so both the students and public would be able to see the trees mature. The type of tree is significant in that they are the same type of trees that are prevalent in the New England area. Their fall color is exceptional. Some students, teachers, and administrators as well as North Scott Rotary members all helped plant the trees for generations to enjoy! Plans are next fall to hold a ceremony for the entire school and install a bronze plaque between the trees at ground level commemorating the fallen at Sandy Hook Elementary School. 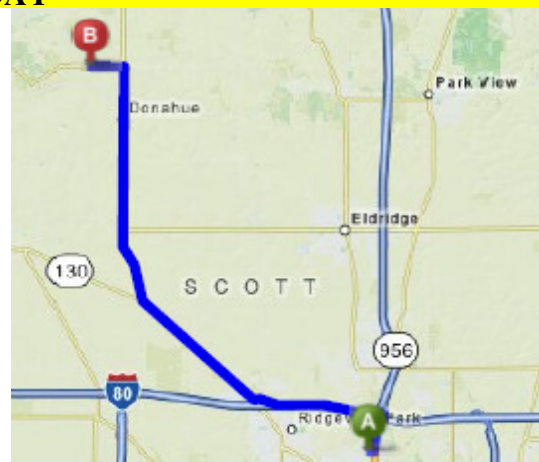

Start out going **northwest** on **IA-130/Northwest Blvd** toward **Hillandale Rd**. Continue to follow **IA-130** 3 mi

Turn **right** onto **115th Ave/CR-Y52**. Continue to follow **CR-Y52**. *CR-Y52 is just past 120th Ave 5.2 mi*

Turn **left** onto **275th St/CR-Y4E**. *275th St is 0.2 miles past N 9th Ave If you reach 283rd St you've gone about 0.7 miles too far .75 (3/4) mile*

10600 275TH ST is on the **right**. *If you reach 102nd Ave you've gone about 0.6 miles too far*

Total 8.78 miles from I-80 Northwest Blvd intersection to John's place.
