Thirty eight North Scott Rotarians viewed John's new robotic dairy operation on Friday. Several spouses and assorted guests were also present. Prospective members in attendance were: Ryan Davis, Jillian Townsell, Rev. Richard Pokora and Tom Wilkerson.

After lunch John explained how the Lely Astronaut robot keeps track of each cow in the herd by its computerized ear tag. Everything they do is recorded, even how many times they chew their cud in a 24 hour period. John's right hand is his daughter, Amy, who after graduating in 3 years from Iowa State and working at three dairy farms across the United States, runs the day to day operations of Cinnamon Ridge Dairy Farm.

It is truly a family affair as John's brother, Dr. Edwin Maxwell, is a certified cheese maker and has begun making cheese curds in an area with windows near the front of the main barn. These were available to sample. Kara Maxwell, Joan Richards and assorted other interns and employees help make Cinnamon Ridge successful.
