### THIS FRIDAY AT THE STEEPLEGATE

The City of Davenport, in collaboration with Iowa State University Extension and Outreach and Davenport Community Schools, received a grant from the Iowa Commission on Volunteer Service to provide at-risk sixteen through nineteen year olds an opportunity to participate in Americorps' Youth Corps program. Continued

Davenport's Youth Corps program engaged youth in 16 hours of workplace soft skill and leadership training during Spring 2012. Youth who completed the program were eligible to apply to participate in the 2012 Summer of Service. During the summer months, these youth were placed in a variety of settings around Davenport to gain career experience, make connections between academics and the world of work, and provide real service to our community. Youth provide 300 hours of service to their communities over ten weeks in exchange for a bi-weekly living allowance and a \$1, 175 educational award to be use for post secondary education and training. Two Youth Corps members, interested in business and marketing, are spending part of their summer documenting the 2012 Summer of Service. As part of their work, they are learning to give presentations to community groups about the Youth Corps Project.
