He and his staff work with potential groups that are seeking expertise in various types of agricultural needs. It may be in crop production, livestock production, fruit or citrus production, canning, drying, packaging, Farm Record Keeping, Farm Management, Business Analysis, Cooperative Development or Strategic Business Planning. He and his staff coordinate the work between a Host and the Volunteer that does the training or teaching.

Mr. Ntibarikure holds a Bachelors Degree in Food Science & Technology and Masters Degree in Chemistry from Makerere University. He has ten years professional experience in agricultural research and worked with International Institute of Tropical Agriculture (IITA). While at IITA, he rose through the ranks to eventually head the Postharvest Program. He also has four years experience working with Farmer-to-Farmer Program at ACDI/VOCA, where he worked as a Program Officer. George is originally from the Western part of Uganda (Kisoro). His family's main activity at home is crop farming and animal rearing. He is married with four children.
