Last Week – George from Uganda– September 21, 2012

Fifty one members and six guests enjoyed hearing George tell about his involvement with the CNFA Farmer to Farmer Program in his home country of Uganda, Africa. His country is about the size of Iowa, but has 34 million people. It has a lot of cultural issues and disease. The majority of the population cannot read or write. Income is very low. George and his host, Merle Anderson, spent time with farmers Glen Keppy and John Maxwell, driving a tractor and viewing the harvest in process.

The CNFA, based in Washington D.C., is helping the population of Uganda with irrigation development, business strategies and market feedback. They are developing crops for income. There are two main groups: grain and oilseeds, such as peanuts, soybeans and sunflowers.

The 50/50 drawing started and Lorraine Lynch was the winner of \$141. Thanks to the 3 ladies who baked pies for the pie auction: Linda Paustian, Mary Golinghorst and Marcia Brandt. And to the buyers of those same pies: Rob White, lemon for \$100, Brad Burt, chocolate for \$70, Lorraine Lynch, peach for \$90 and Eric Langan, peach for \$50.
