THIS FRIDAY AT THE STEEPLEGATE

Polio, does that still exist?

When asking today's youth about the status of polio worldwide, they probably won't be able to give much of an answer, and some may even ask, "That still exists?"

But posing the question to the same age group 50 years ago likely would have generated a different, more informed and possibly fearful answer, as the polio epidemic was just coming to an end. At the time, thousands of polio cases were being reported on a daily basis while, as of last week, only about 300 infections had been detected this year across the globe, according to the World Health Organization (WHO).
