LAST WEEK

LAST WEEK – Dr. Richard Phillis – December 7, 2012

Dr. "Bud" Phillis, retired medical doctor, and Rock Island Rotarian with 25 years of perfect attendance was the speaker on Friday. He lost his twin sister to the dreaded disease of Polio in 1948. He brought some pictures of her with her beautiful long hair. She passed at age 13, after being hospitalized for 4 days. He also suffered from polio at the same time, but his did not affect the lungs or ability to breath. He stated that only one out of 200 are paralyzed from polio and he was not.

Linda Tubbs presented a \$100 check for Polio Plus, as president of the United Methodist Women's group in Eldridge. The group chose this as a worldwide worthy project. Sixty two attended on Friday; with former president of North Scott Rotary, Tom Robinson and Linda being the only guests. Birthdays were celebrated and \$17 was collected for cake.

President John Maxwell was dressed in a Tux and Top Hat, getting warmed up for the Retirement party he was attending that weekend with his fiancée, Joan. He announced the next president elect for July 1, 2016 as Jeff Helms. Steve Suiter was pleased to tell that Tom Messer has accepted the balance of the term left by Adam Kerns, on the current board of directors. Other new board members beginning July 1, 2013 (serving two years) are Marcia Brandt, Jerry Coussens, Lorraine Lynch and Lori Rochau. The slate of nominees received unanimous approval from the membership.
