Sixty six members and guests attended on Friday to learn the opening date of the new Menards R5 store. It will employ 190 team members, with 80 current job openings and has been in the planning for over a year. The new facility will be 240,000 square feet, double the size of the old store. Current department managers are training at the store in Moline, so they will be more familiar with the Davenport expansion when it has its soft opening April 1, 2014. The Grand Opening will be April 13 and will include several celebrities, including someone from the Cubs, the Bears and possibly the St. Louis Cardinals.
