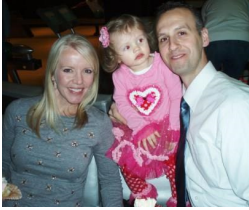

## North Scott Rotary Friends and Family Valentine Celebration

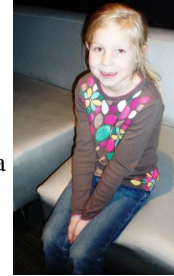

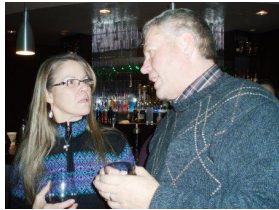
