#### FAMSCO

#### Fire and Medical Supply Co.

**Want to participate in an international Rotary Service project without leaving the country?** Join us to pack boxes for Guatemala on Sunday, May 18, 1 – 4 pm at the Rotary warehouse in Coralville. We'll fill them with medical supplies and equipment as one of our FASMCO projects. Contact Becky Bray if you'd like to lend a hand to this international service project.

FAMSCO, the Fire and Medical Supply Company, was formed as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization in Rotary District 6000. The purpose is to procure emergency vehicles, medical equipment and supplies to ship to developing countries. Over 200,000 tons of supplies and 72 emergency vehicles have been donated since this work was started about 20 years ago.

Originally a project of the Iowa City Rotary Club, FAMSCO soon demonstrated its ability to effectively fulfill its mission and began to receive financial support from all of the Clubs and Rotarians in District 6000. This enabled FAMSCO to expand its scope, and to date it has sent shipments not only to Guatemala, but also to Honduras, El Salvador, Mexico and Colombia.

LAST MEETING – April 25, 2014 – Club Assembly: President Elect Steve Fahrenkrog  
Marty O'Boyle: Voter Info, New City Hall, Police Station

President Elect Steve opened the program section by asking members to fill out the membership survey and volunteer for the committee's they wish to serve on for next Rotary year. He explained the structure chart and said his emphasis is on membership and for the members to continue to build relationships with each other. He also touched on the reasoning for the selection of the location. Two public informational meetings were held in April for the residents to tour the current facilities and look at the proposed floor plans of the new building.

A Voter Referendum is being held on May 6, for residents to cast their vote in favor of this much needed building.
