LAST MEETING – June 6, 2014 – Douglas Rick with Iowa D.O.T.

Douglas Rick is a Civil Engineer with the Iowa Department of Transportation. He is the project manager for the new Interstate 74 corridor bridge project.....and he LOVES bridges. The current bridge system over I74 is obsolete, too short and yields a lot of accidents. The project has started by the acquisition of properties and many other pre-planning projects. The actual bridge building work over the river will be beginning in July 2017 and be completed by 2020. The new bridge will be 3 lanes in each direction with 12 foot shoulders. It will be a twin arch design and also have a 14 foot pedestrian trail.
