### THIS FRIDAY AT THE STEEPLEGATE



Maggie Tinsman was on a 10-member Rotary Friendship Exchange team from District 6000 that was hosted in the homes of Rotarians in South Africa from April 17 to May 8. This Friday, she will share her insights about that amazing country and the opportunities that are available to all Rotarians through Rotary Friendship Exchange.

Maggie has been a member of the Rotary Club of Davenport since 1995 and served in the Iowa Senate for 18 years after having served on the Scott County Board of Supervisors for 11 years. A resident of Bettendorf, she earned a bachelor of arts degree in sociology from the University of Colorado, and later went on to the University of Iowa where she received a master of social work degree. In 2008, she received an honorary doctor of public service degree from St. Ambrose University.

One of her many accomplishments in public service was the introduction of legislation to make human trafficking a felony in Iowa. Currently, she serves on numerous local and state boards, and she owns and operates a consultant business, "Maggie Tinsman, LLC", which specializes in early childhood education development, lobbying for health and human services issues, and in promoting elected public service for women. She is a co-founder of an organization called "50-50 in 2020" to recruit, train, and mentor women for elected positions in Iowa. Currently, she has become a major speaker on the "Global and Local Problems of Human Trafficking" and founded "Breaking Traffic," an organization dedicated to eradicating sex trafficking in Iowa and Illinois. -- Bill Tubbs
