North Scott Rotary Serves Xstream Clean Up Lost Grove Lake Junior League of the Quad Cities 5K Mudventure race

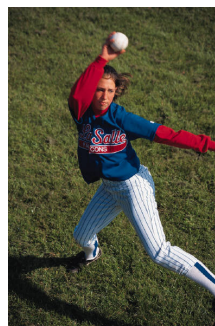
