This Friday remember to come to Spring Brook Country Club in Dewitt, Iowa for the annual Golf Outing.

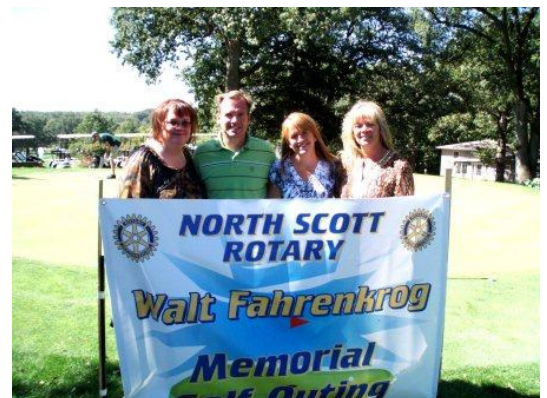
This Best Ball, Shotgun Start, tournament allows all golfers to have a good time and good fellowships with other North Scott Rotary Members.

Seventy members and guests attended on Friday to hear Ken Bonnet's report on the proposed casino for the Quad City area, replacing Isle of Capri on the riverfront. If an agreement is made between the Isle and Dan Kehl's group, who Bonnet represents, the new facility would be built somewhere in northern Scott County by late 2015 – early 2016.

The new facility would be similar to the Riverside, Iowa location, less the golf course. It has been open since 2006 and has been very successful. All of its initial investors have been paid off.
