If an agreement is made between the Isle and Dan Kehl's group, who Bonnet represents, the new facility would be built somewhere in northern Scott County by Iate 2015 – early 2016.

The new facility would be similar to the Riverside, Iowa location, less the golf course. It has been open since 2006 and has been very successful. All of its initial investors have been paid off.
