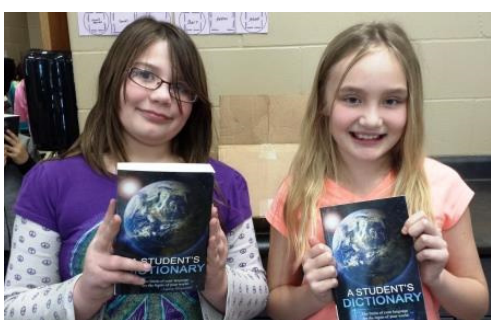

### LAST WEEK

LAST MEETING – February 5, 2016 – Bob Gallagher; Mayor of Bettendorf

Bob Gallagher says that Bettendorf is the premier city of the Quad Cities to live in and that nine of ten residents feel that Bettendorf is a good place to live. Bettendorf is financially sound and has a riverfront destination for entertainment. The Family Museum draws up to 172,000 visitors per year. It receives one million dollars from the city every year, so it can continue to bring in new exhibits and draw visitors.

Bettendorf has the huge project of the Interstate 74 bridge project, which will be ongoing for at least five more years. The Iowa DOT purchased 44 Bettendorf properties to prepare for the bridge expansion. The existing bridge will be blown up in 2021.

Fifty one attended on Friday including Rock Island Rotarian Justin Peterson. Other guests were Barb Dunn Swanson, guest of Becky Bray and Rev. Ron Barnett, guest of Bob Bainter. Patrick was the sergeant and collected \$66 in fines.

Glen announced that the board meeting has been changed to February 19. Patrick encouraged attendance at the Quad City Rotary clubs meeting at St. Ambrose on February 25. Jeff Ashcraft announced the formation of a special committee for the direction of surplus auction funds.
