If you look closely you can see the black monitor on Rylie's waist that is a part of her glucose monitoring system. Rylie is 15 years old and is a freshman at North Scott High School. She was diagnosed with Type 1 Diabetes in Sep-

tember 2013 (her 7th grade year). She is involved in many activities, academically is a strong student, has a summer job working up at the local park, puts in volunteer hours, and is a great sister, daughter, teammate, and friend. This past year she played varsity basketball and soccer, and also ran cross country. She is determined to not let Type 1 stop her from doing all the things she loves to do. Although there are still many years to make a career decision, she is very interested in the medical field; still not sure what area of focus but would like to spend her time helping improving the lives of others through some type of health care with her current ambitions of being a medical physician.

Rylie has been very active in generating funds for the Type 1 diabetes walk. For the third year in a row she was the leading fundraiser for the walk in the Quad Cities, generating around \$10,000 in her first year, closer to \$11,000 in year 2 and \$12,000 for the 2016 walk. Our goal is to hit a 4 year accumulated total of \$50,000, making next year's goal bigger than ever! Why is she so determined to raise funds for this organization? This past year she began wearing a new continuous glucose monitor; this monitor has made a huge difference in her quality of life and is just one example of the progress made with Type 1 partially due to the efforts of JDRF.

Although faced with this challenging disease, Rylie is determined to find the good that can come from such a diagnosis. She is very blessed with the support of many including coaches, teammates, family, and friends.

LAST MEETING– June 10, 2016 – P.J. Foley; St. Ambrose University Wellness and Recreation Center

Two more new members were inducted on Friday, by past president Steve Suiter. Scott Earl and Tyler Bindrum joined and were welcomed by the club and their sponsors, Pat DeLuca and Pat Olsen. See the front page for more info about them.

Glen Keppy announced the new board members for July 1, 2016. The presidential nomination for 2019-2020 is Jeremy Kaiser. New board members for a two year term will be Tricia Kane, Nathan Kessler, Patrick Olsen and Ryan Varner. The sergeant of arms for one year will be Josh Cobie. Paul Seelau and Terrye Kishiue will each serve the remaining one year, of the terms of Aimee Nash (moved) and Ryan Davis (resigned from board). Rich Golinghorst and Gene Meyer have completed their two year terms and were thanked for their service.

Sixty six attended on Friday, including Rotarian Duncan Cameron, from Naples, FL. Other guests were Megan Olsen, Pastor Ron and Janne Barnett. Pastor Ron said goodbye and thanked the club for accepting him, as his year in Eldridge draws to a close. Pat Olsen was the sergeant and collected \$97 in fines.

P.J. Foley, director of public relations for St. Ambrose was the speaker. He told about the 18.5 million dollar Building Our Future Campaign, for the primary project of The Wellness and Recreation Center. About 4 million has been raised, with RDA being a large contributor. The sports teams from St. Ambrose currently practice in about 20 different locations. This new 80,000 square foot building will house 4 multipurpose courts, a 6 lane track, a 2 story cardio workout area and much more. Phase one of the complexes has been completed, phase 2 & 3 are in the future plans.
