LEARN ABOUT VOCATIONAL TRAINING TEAMS; A NEW ROTARY FOUNDATION PROGRAM

The Rotary District 6420 Vocational Training Team from northern Illinois recently returned from a two-week project in Combarbalá, Chile, and they will tell us about their extraordinary work this Friday at North Scott Rotary. (District 6420 was a pioneer of VTT, which replaced Group Study Exchange as a Rotary Foundation program. District 6000 has not thus far sponsored a VTT.)

The team leader, and presenter, is P. Carter Newton, the publisher of the *Galena (Ill.) Gazette*. He chairs the District 6420 VTT Committee and served as pro-

ject manager for the Combarbalá VTT project. For Carter, this was his sixth visit to Combarbalá.

Our second speaker will be Stephanee Jordan, who is the English Language Learner (ELL)/bilingual coordinator for the Moline-Coal Valley School District. She has 28 years of bilingual teaching experience and is an Iowa native.

The team left the Quad Cities International Airport on June 12 and after an overnight stay in Santiago, Chile's capital, the team took a six-hour bus ride 250 miles north to Combarblá. The eight-member team completed its work on Friday, June 26.

The educational mission of the team focused on working with teachers of English in the Commune of Combarbalá. A commune in Chile is comparable to a county in the United States. The town of Combarbalá is the government seat of the commune. Team members worked with teachers who specialized in the teaching of English as well as teachers who taught English as a part of a broader teaching load. They worked with the Combarblá teachers to broaden and fine tune their English language teaching skills and well as further develop their own English language skills.

Helping students develop stronger English language skills has long been a goal of the community's leadership. These skills are seen as a ticket for enhanced educational and vocational opportunities for young people who have few opportunities at home.

Team members visited numerous schools where they had an opportunity to work with teachers and students in the classroom; however, they concentrated most of their energies toward afternoon workshops and a Saturday workshop where they worked intensively with the teachers.

Team members also worked closely with community members who held tourism-related jobs and who wanted to begin developing their English language skills. Morning sessions were held for staff members of an observatory. Twenty percent of the visitors to the observatory are English speakers. Evening sessions were held for community members.

This project comes out of a 12-year relationship the Rotary Club of Galena has with the Rotary Club of Combarabalá. The clubs have worked on a number of projects through the years, including the construction of public restrooms in the town square.
