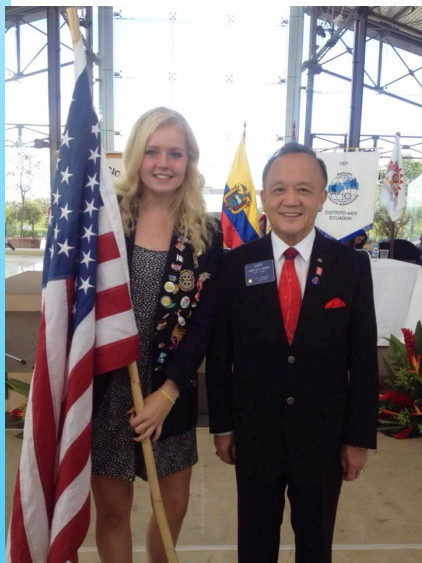

One of the things I did in this time was go to a city called Ambato with my friend Noe. She is another exchange student from a different program that is in my school. We went for Fiestas de Ambato I got to go to a concert of an artist that is pretty famous here, and a parade in the city. It was amazing because all of the floats in the parade were decorated entirely by flowers, bread, and fruits. I also really enjoyed getting to know her extended host family better. Something really cool that happened in March was that the world president of Rotary, Gary C.K. Huang, came to Quito. All of the exchange students of the area were invited to hear him speak. He was surprisingly entertaining and the event was quite fun. Of course, it was awesome to see all of my exchange friends because I don't get to see them all that often. By far the best thing that has happened recently though was my trip to the Galapagos Islands!! I just got back on Friday. It was a five day trip and one of the most amazing experiences of my life. The first day we traveled and when we got there we went to Tortuga Bay, a beach.

I saw black iguanas for the first time and played in the waves all afternoon with my friends. The second day we went to Isla Bartolome in a boat. The boat ride was long, I think 2 hours, but it was amazing because for maybe 25 minutes 5 wild dolphins swam with our boat! Then we had the opportunity to snorkel and hike up to the top of a little mountain that was made of lava. The third day we went to Isla Isabela, where we snorkeled again, saw sea lions, flamingos, and giant turtles. The fourth we went to a place called Sleeping Lion to snorkel again. This was the best snorkel experience. The water was so deep that we couldn't see the bottom but extremely clear and blue, and the rocks above us were extremely tall. This day we swam with sea turtles, tuna, small sharks, and jelly fish. It was incredible. It was truly one of the best weeks of my life and I'm so grateful.
