Do you struggle with keeping silent in the face of demeaning and hurtful stereotypes?

Barbara Dunn Swanson, our speaker this Friday, will give us some tools to deal with the stress that has come into our personal and business lives because of the polarization of our politics and culture. The program, "OUCH! That Stereotype Hurts," teaches useful, easy-to-learn phrases and skills for speaking up against bias and stereotypes.

Barbara is a Human Science Specialist for Iowa State University Extension and Outreach. In that role, she facilitates learning experiences with individuals and groups to strengthen family relationships and build community capacity, including wellbeing, early care and education, caregiving, and developing family resilience.

Barbara is originally from Dubuque. She attended Iowa State University, where she earned bachelor of science and master of science degrees in Family and Consumer Sciences. She worked as a 4-H specialist for 26 years before becoming a Human Sciences Specialist. She worked in both North Carolina and in Iowa.
