Some of you asked if there are notes from the "OUCH! That Stereotype Hurts" training. Yes, there are. What we heard at Rotary today was a condensed version of a two-hour session that Barb Dunn-Swanson of ISU Extension presented to a group I am involved with Wednesday night. The objective of the training is to help participants: 1. Understand the impact of stereotypes and biased statements, even when casually said; 2. Identify the most common reasons people sit silent in the face of bias and stereotypes; and 3. Enhance skills for speaking up against stereotypes without blame or guilt. At the end of the training, Barb handed out a 2-sided business card with the key points. They are below. I hope this helps. Have a great weekend.

1. Assume Good Intent and Explain Impact: "I know you mean well, but that hurts."
2. Ask a Question: "What do you mean?"
3. Interrupt and redirect: "Let's not go there."
4. Broaden to Universal Human Behavior: "I think that applies to everyone."
5. Make it Individual: "Are you speaking of someone in particular?"
6. Say "Ouch!"
