ROTARY FOUNDATION DAY SPEAKER:

AMBASSADORIAL SCHOLAR JENNIFER BLAIR

Jennifer Blair is the Assistant Director for Undergraduate Programs for the Tippie College of Business at the University of Iowa. She is a native of Knoxville, Iowa, who was a Rotary Foundation Ambassadorial Scholar to Ireland in 1998-99. Like most of the 38,000 men and women who were Ambassadorial Scholars from 1947 to 2013, it was a life-changing experience.

As part of our Rotary Foundation Day this Friday at North Scott Rotary, Jennifer will tell us about the Rotary Scholars program and what it meant to her life and many others. It was the original program of The Rotary Foundation in 1947 and its alumnae are leaders in business, education and diplomatic corps worldwide. The name of the program was changed in 2013 from Ambassadorial Scholars to Rotary Scholars, but the mission remains: To further international understanding and friendly relations among people of different countries and geographical areas. While abroad, scholars served as goodwill ambassadors to the host country and gave presentations about their homelands to Rotary clubs and other groups. Upon returning home, they shared with Rotarians and others the experiences that led to a greater understanding of their host country.

We met Jennifer at the Grant Management Seminar at West Liberty in February and later invited her to speak. She readily accepted and it is our honor to welcome her to share her inspirational story with us at Foundation Day at North Scott Rotary.

Foundation Minute for Week of May 8

According to the World Health Organization, nearly 830 women die every day from preventable causes related to pregnancy and childbirth. 99% of maternal deaths occur in developing countries where nearly half of all mothers and newborns do not receive care during and after birth. The leading causes of death for children under 5 are birth complications pneumonia, birth asphyxia, diarrhea and malaria. The deaths can be prevented and treated with access to healthcare services.

Rotary members are working diligently towards eliminating these causes. They provide education, immunizations, birth kits, mobile health clinics, and much more. Women are taught how to prevent mother-to-infant-HIV transmission, how to breast-feed and how to protect themselves and their children from disease.

In the Philippines Rotary clubs are providing cradle boxes for newborn babies. Each box contains postpartum care materials and newborn supplies such as healthcare kits and clothing.

In Ghana, The Rotary Club of Accra East conducted a community-wide medical outreach program where more than 300 women and children benefited from health screenings and received necessary medical supplies.

And in Bangladesh, the Rotary Club of Dhaka North assisted poor pregnant women no cost surgeries and other necessary medicine during emergencies.
