WHAT WE NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE ZIKA VIRUS: with Dr. Louis Katz

Dr. Katz is Chief Medical Officer of America's Blood Centers in Washington, D.C., which operates in 40 states. Since 1996 he has been the medical director for the Scott County Board of Health. In the early 1980s, as HIV was recognized as an issue for transfusion medicine, he was asked to serve as a consultant, and subsequently medical director, at the Mississippi Valley Regional Blood Center, headquartered in Davenport and now serving more than 80 hospitals in four states. He retired as the Executive Vice President, Medical Affairs, in September 2012 when he took his current position with America's Blood Centers.

Dr. Katz completed his residency in internal medicine and fellowship in infectious diseases at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics in disciplines. Starting in 1982, he practiced clinical infectious diseases at Genesis Medical Center in Davenport and was the Hospital Epidemiologist. He established Iowa City and is board certified in both a comprehensive Ryan White-funded HIV/AIDS clinic, the Community Health Care Regional Virology Center, where he practiced until his retirement from active patient care in 2009.

Dr. Katz is an adjunct clinical professor of Internal Medicine and Infectious Diseases at the Roy and Lucille Carver College of Medicine at the University of Iowa. During his career in transfusion medicine he has served on many committees and task forces with regional and national organizations. Dr. Katz is a past chair of the America's Blood Centers Scientific, Medical and Technical Committee, and a past president of ABC. He is a past chair of the American Association of Blood Bank's Transfusion Transmitted Diseases Committee. He has twice served on the Food and Drug Administration's Blood Products Advisory Committee including a term as its chair. Dr Katz and his wife, Jane, live and raise horses on their farm near Tipton, in rural Cedar County, Iowa
