Tips for MVF workers:

Try to arrive 15 minutes before your shift begins. Wear your gold "Rotarians at Work" tee shirt (if you have one).

Park in the East parking lot, which you enter from Locust Street. Report to the Per Mar trailers, located directly under the MVF towers, located at the Locust Street entrance.

Per Mar will give you instructions. They will give you a ride to the East Center Gate, as you will have a cash box and fair tickets in your possession. This gate is located between the brick restroom building and the Starlight ballroom, directly on the East parking lot. One person on each shift should bring a lawn chair.
