Bruce Harreld

President, The University of Iowa

Bruce Harreld became the 21st president of the University of Iowa on November 2, 2015. He received a Bachelor of Engineering degree from Purdue University and a Master of Business Administration degree from Harvard University.

President Harreld served on the faculty of Harvard Business School from 2008–2014, with dual appointments to the entrepreneurial and strategy units. He was faculty chair of the Building New Businesses in Established Organizations program. He also has been an adjunct professor at Northwestern University in the Kellogg School of Management.

President Harreld has served in several corporate leadership positions. As senior vice president and division president of Kraft General Foods, he led the strategic unit that formulated strategy and executed acquisitions for this multibillion-dollar company. As president and board member of Boston Market Company, he, along with five other partners, led the organization from 20 stores in the Boston area to over 1,100 stores nationally. As senior vice president of IBM, President Harreld worked with the CEO and senior man-

agement team to chart the organization's transformation from near bankruptcy. President Harreld has also served as a consultant on leadership, organic growth, and strategic renewal.

President Harreld is the author or coauthor of numerous articles and book chapters and has also authored or coauthored several case studies for Harvard Business Publishing. He has received several awards, including the Accenture Award for best business article of the year and the Distinguished Industrial Engineer and Distinguished Engineering Awards from Purdue University.

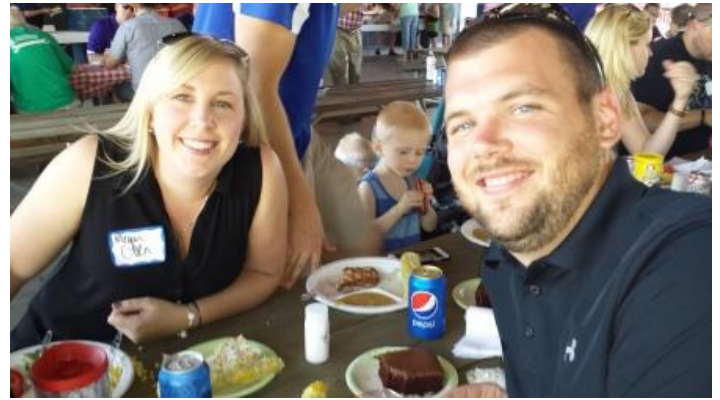

John Deere Classic Volunteers - Hole Marshalls

The John Deere Classic will take place on August 11-14, 2016. The Pro-Am takes place on Wednesday, August 10.

In cooperation with the Iowa Quad-Cities Rotary Club, we will be marshaling #16 again this year. We need you to consider being a marshal for one or two days. It is fun and you get to see professional golfers up close. You do not need to be a golfer to marshal.

Sign-up at Rotary on one of the sheets on your table. John Gere will confirm the date(s) of your preference. You can then register at the John Deere Classic web site. Indicate that you are with the Iowa Quad-Cities / North Scott Rotary Clubs and marshal on #16.

You are required to purchase a JDC shirt for \$25. If you want to wear a cap, it must be a JDC cap. They cost \$10. A visor is \$10 or you can buy a floppy hat or a straw hat for \$15. Those items will be available to pick up at the John Deere World Headquarters on Tuesday, July 26 from 4-8 PM, Wednesday, July 27 from 4-8 PM or Thursday, July 28 from 10 AM - 2 PM.

You must wear khaki or stone slacks or shorts. Shifts normally start about 8:15 AM and runs until about 5:00 PM. A light lunch and water are provided. Bring along a lawn chair.
