COLONEL DONALD K. WOLS COMMANDER Rock Island Arsenal

Colonel Donald K. Wols serves as the 48th commander of the Rock Island Arsenal Joint Manufacturing and Technology Center (RIA-JMTC), a position he has held since June 25, 2015. As Commanding Officer, Colonel Wols oversees operations of the only multi-purpose and vertically integrated metal manufacturer in the Department of Defense, applying the unique technical expertise and equipment to manufacture products high in quality and sustainability.

Colonel Wols came to RIA-JMTC from the United States First Army, where he served as Deputy Chief of Staff G-4 (Logistics) at Rock Island, Ill. Prior to that, he served as the Executive Officer (XO) for the Chief of Staff of the Army Materiel Command at Redstone Arsenal, Ala.

Colonel Wols was born and raised in Hood River, Oregon, and is a proud graduate of Hood River Valley High School. After four years at Northwest Nazarene University, Nampa, Idaho, and a short stint at St. Johns College, Santa Fe, New Mexico, he enlisted in the Army in 1988. After graduating from the Defense Language Institute as a Czech linguist, he was assigned to the 3rd Armored Cavalry Regiment where he deployed in support of Operations Desert Shield and Storm. He was selected to attend Officer Candidate School in 1992, was commissioned as an Infantry Officer, and subsequently assigned to the 2-7 Cavalry Regiment, 3rd Brigade, 1st Cavalry Division.

Colonel Wols earned a Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy from Northwest Nazarene University, a Master of Military Arts and Science in History from the US Army Command and General Staff College, and a Master of Strategic Studies from the Air University. His decorations include the Bronze Star Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, Meritorious Service Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters, Combat Action Badge, Expert Infantry Badge, Master Parachutist Badge, Ranger Tab, and Rigger Badge.

Colonel Wols is married and has two children.
