LAST WEEK – September 23, 2016 – Colonel Donald Wolbs; Rock Island Arsenal

Colonel Wolbs told sixty six members and guests about some of the things that go on, on Arsenal Island. 1141 people are employed there, 996 of them are permanent employees. The balance is military personnel, temps or contractors. 56% reside in Illinois, 44% reside in Iowa. The island houses the manufacturing division. They don't compete with private industry and they make various new items from molten metal. They are a not for profit industry and recently secured a contract with the Navy.

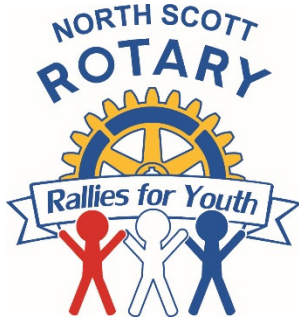
