Even the counties that do not have a casino receive funding. On the average a person will spend \$60 at a casino in one visit. Over 50 per cent of the employees in the state are women. A lot of management is women also. When the casinos first opened there was a \$60 lose limit. That didn't last long. Several programs are available to help people who have a gambling addiction.
