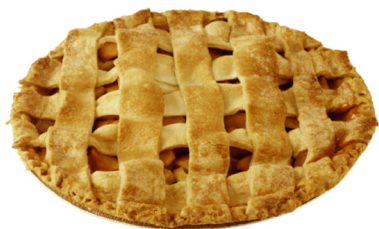

Chief Judge Marlita Greve is most concerned about the decreasing number of judges in our area, the drop in rank for the Iowa chamber and the lack of funding available, due to the legislature. The seventh Judicial District is the smallest district in Iowa; however it has 70,000 cases a year. It has only 5 counties: Cedar, Clinton, Jackson, Muscatine and Scott. Judges are hard to come by, this district needs five more. Two were nominated last week. Many attorneys chose to stay in private practice.
