Dues are now \$165 per quarter. We would need an additional \$10 per member, per quarter to break even.

Your Board has voted to increase dues \$5 per quarter both January 2017 and January 2018. Each increase is less than 40 cents per week or per meal.

The last increase was January 2016, but we were presented with and immediate meal increase that more than used up this dues increase. We will experience no meal increase during this time frame due to negotiations with the Steeplegate Restaurant. These dues do not allow for any social events or other club expenses.

Just as a reference point, at a recent club Presidents meeting, dues were discussed..
