LAST WEEK – February 23, 2018 – Lancer Legacy: Joe Stutting and Nick Hansel

Sixty seven attended on Friday including guests: Nick Hansel, Nancy Case and Rotarian Steve Berger from Wellman, Iowa. Also Bob Doerfer, guest of Alex Dirck, Heather Link and Rev. Jay Wolin, guests of Bill Tubbs, Tony Knobbe, guest of Ken Tank and John Hutchcroft, who is joining soon.

Josie Seymour proudly announced the plans for the Cambria Hotel Bettendorf that will be built at the new sports complex at Middle Road and Interstate 80. The Frontier Hospitality Group will develop and build the facility. The community needs committee met before the regular meeting. Announcements of funds awarded will be after the March 16 board meeting.

Nick Hansel and Joe Stutting gave all the details about the project plans and goals for the current and future projects for the North Scott High School renovation projects. The current one that actually started this week is the \$3.7 million renovation of the Auditorium. The Lancer Legacy Fund will supply \$500,000 toward this project.

The total of ALL the projects is expected to be \$9.2 million. Sales tax support and school funds will supply \$7.2 million. The Lancer Legacy campaign committee (of 2 people) hopes to raise the remaining \$2 million. Donations of ANY amount are welcome.
