LAST WEEK – June 1, 2018 – Mary Mosiman: Auditor of the State of Iowa

Sixty four attended on Friday. June birthdays were celebrated and Leroy Paustian won the June 50/50 drawing of \$95. John Maxwell was the sergeant and collected \$20 in fines.

We had the new member induction of Ryan Johnson (see front page). Blue badges were awarded to Tracy Lindaman and Matt Maiers. Merle Anderson asked for John Deere Classic volunteers. Jeff Ashcraft asked members to sign up for his installation at Sheridan Meadows Park on June 21. Bill Tubbs announced the death of Birch Holden, a charter member of NSR.

Mary Mosimann, CPA and Auditor of State Offices for the State of Iowa, was introduced by Rich Horst. She claims to be every taxpayer's watchdog. Her office is responsible for the financial audits for all 99 counties in Iowa, over 900 cities, many school districts and community colleges.

Mary explained what her duties are and why every office should have internal controls. Credit card statements and bank statements should always be reviewed and reconciled. Pin numbers should be kept hidden and tax returns should be kept secure. Even turning off the light, locking doors on home and car, installing smoke detectors and using speed control are forms on internal control. Prevent-Detect-Correct.....something from going wrong. She gave examples of how people begin to use company funds in a small way, don't get caught, so just keep up the fraud.
