FRIDAY'S PROGRAM: RITA HART, CANDIDATE FOR IOWA LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

On June 16, Fred Hubbell picked state Sen. Rita Hart to be his running mate for Governor of Iowa. Friday, she will be our speaker at North Scott Rotary.

Sen. Hart and her husband, Paul, owned and operated a farm in the Wheatland community since 1986. They have five children. In addition, Sen. Hart is a 20-year educator in public schools at Calamus-Wheatland and Bennett. She is a graduate of North Iowa Area Community College and holds a bachelor of arts degree in education from the University of Northern Iowa and a master of arts degree in educational administration from the University of Iowa.

Sen. Hart was elected to the Iowa Senate in 2012 and re-elected in 2014 in District 49, which serves all of Clinton County and northern and eastern Scott County.

Sen. Hart is an Assistant Leader and ranking member on the Agriculture and Natural Resources Budget Committee. She also serves on the Agriculture, Appropriations, Education and Natural Resources committees. She also serves on the Economic Development Appropriations Subcommittee, the International Relations Committee, the Local Government Mandates Study Committee, the Recycling Policy Study Committee, the Early Childhood Iowa State Board, the Economic Development Authority Board, the Human Rights Board, the Prevention of Disabilities Policy Council, and the Watershed Improvement Review Board.

She previously served as a member of the Clinton County Coordinating Justice Commis-

sion, the Clinton County Planning and Zoning Commission, and was a befriender at Genesis West Hospital, Dav-
 enport. She also presently serves as chair of Clinton County Economic Development Coordinating Council. She
 is a board member of the Salvation Army in Clinton, member and cantor at St. Ann's Catholic Church, Long
 Grove, and serves as the International Exchange Coordinator for High School Exchange (EF).

LAST WEEK – July 13, 2018 – Jim Peterson; D6000 Chair Xicotepec Project

President Jeff Ashcraft explained that the club will not be working at the Fair this year, as the East Gate where we have worked is being closed. Ryan Varner talked about the Mud Run Obstacle Course event on August 18 in Coal Valley, IL.

Jim Peterson from the Iowa City A.M. Rotary Club formed a team of 6 Rotarians in 2003 to go to Xicotepec, Mexico to partner with a local Rotary club. They have many projects to work on there, mostly to build schools, provide simple medical and dental care, read to the children, organize classrooms, etc. He was inspired to lead this team by Ray Muston and Gary and Nancy Pacha, and has been willingly doing so for 16 years. 1000 members have participated in this project over the 16 years, many being University of Iowa students.

The trip is over Spring Break in March. The application will be available on Xicoproject.org soon. The all-inclusive trip runs around \$1850.00 for each person. No Rotary project supports this team.
