THIS FRIDAY AT THE STEEPLEGATE TAKE A TRIP TO ANTARCTICA WITH JOHN AND DEB OCKENFELS



It may be hot in July, but at Rotary on July 12th, take a trip to Antarctica with Rotarians John and Deb Ockenfels. In 2017 John and Deb experienced our seventh continent and are eager share their experiences and observations. And in 2020, John, who is an experienced pilot, is planning to fly around the world with Rotarians to raise funds for PolioPlus.

The Ockenfelses are members of the Rotary Club of Iowa City AM, and John was District Governor of Rotary District 6000 in 2014-15. John is retired from the business, City Carton Recycling, which his family built into one of the premier recycling businesses in the U.S. Deb is retired as an operating room

nurse at University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics.

They are dedicating their retirement years to Service Above Self through Rotary. They have participated in the Iowa Miles Of Smiles Team which performs cleft lip and cleft palate repairs for children in Guatemala. They have been members of District 6000's Project Team to Xicotepec, Mexico, and in 2002, John participated in a Polio National Immunization Day in Mumbai, India. Recently, John is serving as co-chair of RAG4Clubfoot, the Rotarian Action Group that was begun by Iowa Rotarians to train doctors worldwide in the Ponseti Method of non-invasive clubfoot repair.

Earlier this year, Rotarians in Iowa City dedicated a cooler at the CommUnity Food Bank in honor of the Ockenfelses, in appreciation of their extraordinary generosity providing thousands of pounds of fresh produce for the food bank. And Deb has stitched fabulous quilts which have raised funds for polio and other Rotary projects at District 6000 events. The Ockenfelses have done much for many ... but Friday will be about adventure.

So let's relax and kick off a new Rotary year with President Jeremy Kaiser and let the Ockenfelses take us places we have never been. – *Bill Tubbs*
