LAST WEEK – February 8, 2019 – Mike Miller: Riverbend Food Bank and Pete Vogel: Food Rescue QC

Fifty-nine attended on Friday, February 8. Guests were Davenport Rotarian, Bill Burress, Dr. Diane Papke-Cole, Jason Happel, Brian Williams and Ryan Pearson, guest of Josie Seymour.

Jeff Ashcraft encouraged members to attend the Tryke Build on Saturday. Josie Seymour asked for people to sign up for the Valentine lunch. Greg Schaapveld promoted the Quad City Storm Ice Hockey game on Friday night, February 15, at 7 pm. Tickets will still be available at the meeting on Friday. Brian Williams told about an event WQPT is having on March 16.

Josie filled in as sergeant, in the absence of Bill Tubbs. She collected \$31 in fines and even phoned a friend (Bill) as he attended a newspaper convention in Des Moines.

Mike Miller and Pete Vogel gave a lot of useful information! 42.2 million Americans are food insecure, which includes 15 million children. AND on the other hand, 35 million tons of food are thrown away annually. The Food Rescue program is reasonably new. There is no longer a liability to give away prepared or soon outdated food. The rescue program will pick up excess food and repurpose it to an organization like King's Harvest, to feed the homeless, or for someone to feed their animals.

The River Bend Foodbank serves 23 counties in Iowa and Illinois. They stock 23 food pantries and many supplemental programs. Food pantries purchase items from them for pennies on the dollar. They also participate in the back-pack program where kids take home a backpack with some food items for the family for the weekend. Otherwise, many families may not have food for the weekend. The Foodbank can always use volunteers. They need about 28,000 per year.
