North Scott Rotary is pleased to welcome Dr. Wintersteen on Friday, April 12 as the speaker at their noon meeting in the Williamsburg Room of the Best Western Plus Steeplegate Inn, 100 W. 76th St., Davenport, Iowa. The club invites any interested rotarians, their guests, and prospective members to attend. Please rsvp if possible to NSRotary@aol. com. Cost for the meal is \$13 and can be paid at the door.

Dr. Wendy Wintersteen became the 16th president of Iowa State University in 2017, following a nationwide search and unanimous vote of the Board of Regents, State of Iowa. She is the first woman president in Iowa State history. And she's only the second ISU graduate to hold the university's highest office.

Dr. Wintersteen has served Iowa State for 40 years in several capacities, including as one of the first female ISU Extension associates in integrated pest management. She served 11 years as dean of the internationally recognized College of Agriculture and Life Sciences and director of the Iowa Agriculture and Home Eco-

nomics Experiment Station, and she held the university's first endowed deanship. She earned a bachelor's of science degree in crop production from Kansas State University and a Ph.D. in entomology from Iowa State.

As president, and with the support of her administrative team, Dr. Wintersteen is advancing lowa State University with priorities focused on enhancing student success; recruiting and retaining excellent faculty and staff; strengthening innovation and research excellence; developing a culture of entrepreneurship; making Iowa State a leader in creating a welcoming and inclusive campus environment; and growing state and private support for the university, its faculty, staff, and students.
